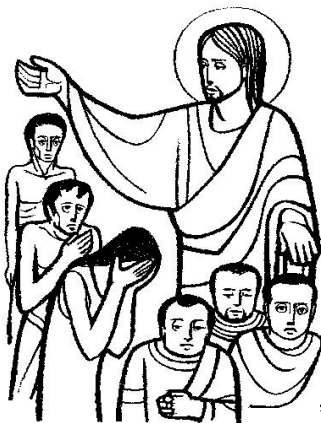

Ash Wednesday falls on 26th February this year. Masses will be celebrated on Ash Wednesday with the distribution of Ashes at 10 a.m. & 7 p.m. There will be services throughout the day for our young people from the three schools in our parish. There will be opportunities for Stations of the Cross on the Monday evenings of Lent at 7 p.m. and scripture meditation on Wednesdays at 7 p.m. These begin the week of 2nd March. There will also be an extra daily Mass celebrated at 8.30 a.m. on Mondays in Our Lady of the Rosary Primary; Tuesday-Thursday in Lourdes Secondary and on Fridays in Lourdes Primary school.
